II. Type of data processed

In this section we indicate the type of data we ask for

Personal data processed fall within the following categories:

Personal data acquired directly from the data subject:

- **Generic personal data:** personal particulars (name, surname, address, date of birth, citizenship, marital status, profession), tax identification number (of employees and/or customers), ID document identifiers (driver's license/ID document/passport number), contact data (e-mail, telephone contacts), bank details, economic-financial and/or income data.

Data acquired automatically while browsing: IP address, type of browser used, information on the pages visited inside the portal, access time.



III. Purposes of the Data Processing

In this section we give the reasons why we request your data

The data we ask you to provide are collected and processed for the following **purposes**:

- a) to implement tenders (*Legal basis: contractual*);
- b) to sign contracts (*Legal basis: contractual*);
- c) to implement contracts (*Legal basis: contractual*);

The provision of data that are needed in order to achieve the aforementioned purposes is "*mandatory*" and any refusal to provide such data could make it impossible for Mercitalia Intermodal S.p.A. to complete tenders, sign contracts and ensure that contracts are properly implemented.



IV. Recipients of personal data

In this section we indicate who will process your data and to whom such data will be communicated

In order to achieve the aforementioned purposes, Mercitalia S.p.A. permits the following parties to process personal data which you provide:

- **Parties specially authorised to carry out data-processing operations:** your personal data will only be accessible to persons inside the company who require such data due to their job duties or based on their reporting lines. These persons will be given suitable guidelines to ensure that data loss, unauthorised access to data or illegitimate data-processing activities are avoided.

Furthermore, personal data may be used by the following categories of persons who carry out instrumental activities on behalf of Italian State Railways Group Companies:

- **I-Faber**, which will manage the data in accordance with the contract with the Companies in order to ensure that confidentiality obligations are observed and that data processing operations are carried out correctly. I-Faber acts as the **Data Processor** on behalf of Mercitalia Intermodal, which is the Data Controller and has signed a special contract that strictly regulates the data-processing operations entrusted to it, and the associated data protection obligations.



V. Dissemination of data

In this section we guarantee that your data will not be disclosed or disseminated

Your personal data will never be published, displayed or made available (including for consultation) to unspecified persons/entities, except in order to implement legal compliance requirements necessary for the aforementioned purposes.



VI. Retention of data

In this section we indicate how long we keep your data

Personal data will be retained for the duration of the contract and for 10 years thereafter.



VII. Rights of Data Subjects

We indicate your guaranteed rights in this section

EU Regulation 2016/679 (Articles 15 to 23) grants specific rights to data subjects. In particular, in relation to the processing of your personal data, the data subject is entitled to request Mercitalia Intermodal S.p.A. to permit data access, correction, erasure, limitation and portability and the right to oppose a data-processing operation; the data subject may also file a complaint with the supervisory authority, which in Italy is the Italian Data Protection Authority.
